Rev. William Cwirla: Roaming through Romans

The Book of Romans is the most comprehensive statement of the Christian faith contained in a single book of the Bible. From God's wrath against sin to His mercy for sinners for Jesus' sake, Romans lays out the central and core tenet of the Christian faith: That a sinner is justified before God by grace through faith for Jesus' sake. In the book of Romans will explore the dynamics of Law and Gospel, wrath and mercy, death and life, and the baptismal life of being sinful and righteous at the same time.

Rev. Peter Ledic: Forgiveness

"Forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us." Christians treasure forgiveness, yet at times are vexed by sins in their past (burdened with guilt toward God). We also experience the interpersonal trauma of having sinned against others (and people sinning against us). Using Holy Scripture as our primary source, but also including Luther's Catechism, the Lutheran Confessions, LSB, and excerpts from TV and movies we will explore the importance of reconciliation toward God and each other.
