schools, community organizing and outreach, and founding a ministry to serve women who were homeless or at risk of homelessness. Her deepest joy (and often also stress) is experienced as the chaos coordinator for the Lewis family that includes her husband, Jeff, son, twin daughters, and crazy dog.
