LODGING

Guests stay in Camp Arcadia's comfortable Inn, pit/assembly hall or cottages. The Inn features bedrooms with a queen and a double bed, or a queen and a bunk bed (bunks use standard single mattresses and are comfortable for adults). There is a sink in each room with bathrooms down the hallways. First floor rooms are available for guests who cannot manage stairs. Additionally, the Inn's first floor has wheel chair accessible rooms and bathrooms. Dormitory-style housing is also available in "The Pit", located in the Assembly Hall. Five cottages, located a short walk from the central camp area, have bathrooms, plus a kitchenette and living area. Linens and towels are provided for all guests. Please note that Camp Arcadia is a smoke free environment.

FACILITIES

Camp Arcadia's three main buildings are located around a central patio area on the Lake Michigan shoreline. All buildings have ramps and are wheel chair accessible. Guests enjoy Camp's large game room in the Wigwam with a piano, Ping-Pong tables, table shuffleboard and bowling, pool tables and a reading room plus a fireplace. Outdoor areas are available for shuffleboard, tennis, basketball, softball and paths for hiking. The Trading Post sells ice cream and snacks, as well as souvenirs.

MEALS

Delicious meals featuring homemade breads, desserts and fresh produce are served in the Inn dining room.

RETREAT COST

The deposit for this retreat is \$100. The \$230 rate includes lodging in a traditional Inn room or the pit/assembly hall, meals, programming, and use of all facilities. There is an additional surcharge of \$27 per person for Inn room with private bath or cottage. For off-site lodging participants, the rate of \$195 covers meals and programming. Programming only is \$100. Guests who cancel after August 1st are subject to a cancellation charge of \$100. On-camp registration begins Thursday at 5 PM. During the retreat, money in the form of tips is collected for the camp staff. All other contributions raised during this retreat are sent to Lutheran Hour Ministries.
