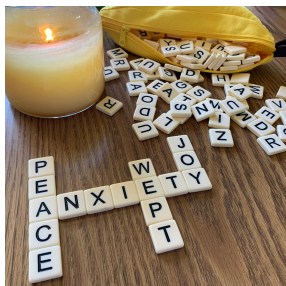


It is our hope and prayer that these prayer stations would provide you with some tools to engage in God's Word and conversation with our Savior.

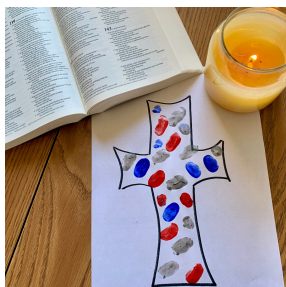
# AT-HOME PRAYER STATIONS

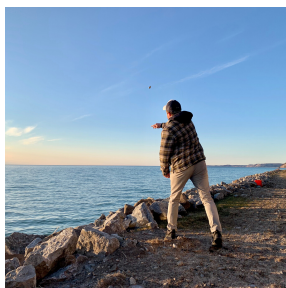

You could pray out-loud as you light a candle and place it on different areas of the world; you can write your prayers on sticky notes and them onto the world map. Pray for God's kingdom to come to earth.
