Vision Statement

Values

Christian Faith with Lutheran Roots

Camp Arcadia's Christian ministry is rooted in the Lutheran tradition. We believe by God's love we are saved through faith in Christ Jesus—not because of anything we have done, not by works, but as a gift of God, so that no one can boast. For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. (Ephesians 2:8-10) In response, we value Christ as the foundation of all our being, activities, events, programs, and opportunities to embody His love.

Christ-Centered Community

The Camp Arcadia community is united by the cross of Christ, and we are called to live in that unity. Our Christ-Centered community of campers, cottagers, and staff is to be a life-giving gathering of people who are:
