Friendly reminders during your stay....

Our watercraft - paddleboards and kayaks - are located at Sunset Beach, just west of the lifeguard chair. Anyone LESS THAN 16 YEARS OLD MUST be accompanied by an adult on any watercraft. State law requires the use of life jackets, and every participant must wear a life jacket the entire time while using the kayaks or paddleboards. Paddles for watercraft can be checked out from the office. For your safety, we will NOT CHECK OUT ANY WATERCRAFT when there are visible whitecaps on the lake. From 1:30-5:00pm, there will be a program staffer at Sunset Beach who can help you launch or land your watercraft.

Please stay off of the revetment rocks and use caution when using the beach. The Minnehaha shipwreck is currently in the pocket beach waters. We recommend the use of water shoes, and we have shoes you may borrow at Sunset Beach.

Guests swim in Lake Michigan at their own risk.

Guests may rent mountain bikes from the Camp office. You must be 16 or older to rent a bike or be accompanied by an adult. Helmets are provided. Please see the office for rates.

As a courtesy to our guests, we offer a range of complimentary toiletry items that are kept in the office. If you have forgotten a standard toiletry item, please stop by the office!
